

## **Man Shoots Gun in the Air**

A man with a gun was arrested around 1:45 a.m. on Oct. 25 after police responded to 911 calls reporting shots fired on the 14500 block of East 14th Street.

When they arrived they found the suspect angry and intoxicated, according to Lt. Randy Brandt of the San Leandro police.

A witness told police that he saw the man shoot the gun into the air. The police got the gun from him and didn't find anyone injured or any property damage at the scene.

The man was arrested on a fire arms charge and is being held on \$85,000 bail at Santa Rita Jail in Dublin.
